7.2 Speed Skating on Road: circuited road 400m with asphalt surface

8.2 Team Formation

8.2.1 Speed Skating (32 skaters in maximum for track and road)

A maximum of 16 male skaters (8 for senior, and 8 for junior) and 16 female skaters (8 for senior, and 8 for junior) are allowed for each participating country /region. Each event is limited to 2 skaters per country / region (relay not included).

8.2.2 Artistic Skating

Figure: 2 men and women for senior, 2 men and women for junior, 2 men and women for cadet

Free Skating: 3 men and women for senior, 3 men and women for junior, 2 men and women for cadet

Pair Skating: 2 pairs

Roller Dance: 2 pairs

Inline Free Skating: 3 men and 3 women

Solo Dance: 2 men and 2 women

Precision: 16 skaters

Quartet: 2 group (4 skaters each)

8.2.3 Freestyle Skating (32 skaters in maximum)

For each country or region: no more than 16 men skaters and no more than 16 women skates are allowed to enter. One skater can compete in different events.

Speed Slalom: a maximum of 6 men skaters (3 seniors and 3 juniors) and 6 women

skaters (3 seniors and 3 juniors)

Classic Freestyle Slalom: a maximum of 6 men skaters (3 seniors and 3 juniors) and 6 women skaters (3 seniors and 3 junior)

Battle Slalom: a maximum of 6 men skaters (3 seniors and 3 juniors) and 6 women skaters (3 seniors and 3 juniors)

Pair Slalom: 2 pairs in maximum

Freestyle Slide: a maximum of 3 men skaters and 3 women skaters

Free Jump: a maximum of 3 men skaters and 3 women skaters

Pair Slalom shall not be classified by age or sex group. Freestyle Slide and Free Jump shall not be classified by age group.

8.2.4 Inline Hockey: 6 to 16 skaters including 2 goalkeepers for each team

8.2.5 Rink Hockey: a maximum of 12 skaters including 3 goalkeepers for each team

8.2.6 Skateboarding (8 skaters in maximum)

A maximum of 4 men skaters and 4 women skaters are allowed for each participating country / region.

8.3 Age Groups

8.3.1 Speed Skating

Senior: born on or before December 31st, 2003

Junior: born between January 1st, 2000 and December 31st, 2003

8.3.2 Artistic Skating

Senior: born on or before January 1st, 2006

Junior: born between January 2nd, 1999 and January 1st, 2006

Cadet: borne between January 2nd, 2005 and January 1st, 2008

For pair skating, roller dance, inline skating, solo dance and Precision, skaters shall be borne on or before January 1st, 2006.

8.3.3 Inline Freestyle Skating

Senior: born on or before December 31st, 2001

Junior: born between January 1st, 2002 and December 31st, 2008

8.3.4 Inline Hockey

Senior: skaters born before December 31st, 2004

Junior: skaters born between December 31st, 2004 and January 1st, 1999

8.3.5 Rink Hockey

Senior: skaters born before December 31st, 2004

Junior: skaters born between December 31st, 2004 and January 1st, 1999

8.3.6 Skateboarding

Skaters born on or before December 31st, 2005

8.4 Passport (ID) control will be organized before competition.

9 COMPETITION METHOD

9.1 The latest version of the rules of every discipline of World Skate shall be applied in the competition.

9.2 It is a must for all skaters from the same team to wear the uniform garments to attend the marching-in ceremony and take part in all competitions. The skates, pats and other equipment should be adequate for the safety of the competition. The helmets are compulsory for speed skating.

9.3 Music

9.3.1 Artistic: Each National Federation must hand the music of its own team in a USB (in mp3). The name of each file should be: Skater's Name_Skater's Last Name – Category (junior/senior) – Modality (free skating, pairs, dance) – short or long programme, style dance or free dance. For Show and Precision the name of the group.

9.3.2 Freestyle: music for Slalom Classic and Pair Slalom must be on MP3 format and must be submitted to the organizer before August 28th, 2018 by email to 2018arsckorea@naver.com, and the name of the MP3 should be: Category – Gender - Skater's Name - Single or Pair Slalom.

10 RANKING & AWARDING

10.1 The top 6 (six) places of each category will be awarded. The top 3 (three) places will be awarded medals and certificates, the 4th to 6th places will be awarded certificates.

10.2 Should the number of participants be less 3 (three persons / pairs / teams), the event shall be organized as demonstrative one. If there is only one participant (person, pair, team), the event shall be cancelled.

10.3 Results of the Australian and New Zealand skaters will be recorded officially, while be ranked and awarded separately, except in the Rink Hockey Competition, as it is the Asia-Oceania Championship.

12 EXPENSES

12.1 Entry Fee

12.1.1 Speed: 50USD/per skater, 50USD/per relay team.

12.1.2 Artistic and Freestyle: 50USD/per skater, 50USD/per pair, 50USD/per team for precision and quartet.

12.1.3 Hockey: 150USD/per team

12.1.4 No entry fee for skaters from Australia and New Zealand, except in the Rink Hockey Competition, as it is the Asia-Oceania Championship;

12.2 Accommodation, food and local transportation

12.2.1 The WSA Central Committee members and appointed international judges are responsible for their traveling expenses, while the local organizer will provide them with free meals and accommodations and local transportation during the official dates of the Championships in Namwon, Korea.

12.2.2 Each team is responsible for their traveling expenses. The official members of all delegations shall pay 90USD per person per day for the package of their board & lodging and local transportation. The accommodation will be double/twin room in resort. The meal will be three buffets per day. If single room is requested, another 40USD per day per person will be charged.

12.2.3 If any delegation doesn't stay in the official hotels, the local organizer is not responsible for their transportation between the official hotels and the competition venue/airport. And an administration fee of 60USD per person shall be charged.

13 About VISA

It is recommended to contact Korean Embassy/Consultant in your country or region and apply for visa ahead of time. In the case that there is any document necessary for application from the Organizer, please let us know well in advance.

14 Airport Transportation

14.1 Incheon International Airport is recommended.

14.2 Organizer will provide airport shuttle from Incheon to Namwon.

14.3 As an option, if some delegations plan to arrive at another airport, the organizer can dispatch bus for minimum 30 people for one time. For example, 1 bus for 30 people, and 2 buses for 60 people.

14.4 The shuttle and bus to and from airport only served for the delegations stay in official hotels.

15 MISCELLANEOUS

15.1 The organizers reserve the right to use the photo, audio & video materials, etc. of all skaters for the purpose of promoting the roller sports.

15.2 It is a must that all participating teams and individuals should buy Insurances against Accidents and Illnesses.

15.3 Your entry & participation shall be regarded as your acceptance of all the articles of those regulations.
